#### About Svante Gullichsen

Svante Gullichsen b.1994 is a Helsinki-based photographer whose work draws on the mystical character often associated with nature in the culture of Nordic countries.

Central to Gullichsen's work are topics around mental health issues, the relation between human and nature as well as the fundamental relation between darkness and light.

His ongoing projects - mostly self-portraits – are telling a story about living with an obsessive-compulsive disorder.
